

Debit/ATM Card Security Tips

- Treat your Debit/ATM Card like cash. Always keep your card in a safe place. Don't write your Personal Identification Number (PIN) on your card or give the number out to anyone. Avoid using numbers that are easily identified for your PIN (birth date, phone number, etc.).
- Be careful to keep your PIN shielded when using the ATM or keying your PIN at a merchant.
- Be cautious when using your debit card online. Make sure the website you're purchasing from is a trusted and secure website.
- If your Debit/ATM Card is lost or stolen, or your secure PIN is compromised, report it immediately to Farmers State Bank at 260.463.7111 or toll free at 888.492.7111. After hours call MasterCard Hot-Card at 866.546.8273.
- Pay attention to where you're inserting your card; if the card reader does not look secure or if it looks like it has been tampered with, notify the bank immediately.
- Monitor your bank statements for any unauthorized activity.
- Call to check your balance and transactions on FSB's 24 Hour Telephone Banking at 260.463.0111 or toll free at 866.463.1110.
- Don't forget to sign up for Farmers State Bank (FSB) Text Alerts. You will get a text message every time your card is used.
